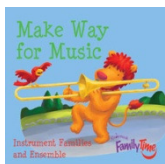


Kindermusik Classes Winter 2012 – start January 30.

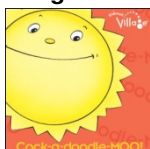
Family Time 0-7 years - *Make Way for Music.* Families will sing, dance, and move their way through an exploration of several elements of music: beat and rhythm, concepts and contrasts (such as staccato and legato, high and low, the major scale, and arpeggios), the human voice, instrument families, and ensemble. They'll engage in developmentally appropriate activities that the whole family can enjoy together, including fingerplays, songs, circle dances, story time, and family jam. *10 weeks – Tuition - \$100 1st child, \$80 2nd child, \$50 3rd + child. Materials - \$55/family.*

Laugh & Learn – 2-4 years - *On the Go/ Home Sweet Home*

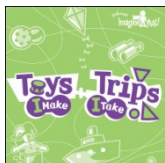
Put a new spin on trains and cars. In class we'll talk about things on the go with a real-sounding train whistle, sound effects, and movement activities that develop your toddler's rhythm and coordination. Then we'll turn our classroom into a pretend house. Through songs and stories, we'll explore different kinds of houses animals make—from spider webs to bird's nests. When you find these homes in your very own backyard, you reinforce the learning that's happening in class. *8 weeks – Tuition - \$80. Materials - \$30*
